VERIFIED NOTICE OF EXEMPTION OF CHICAGO, ROCK ISLAND & PACIFIC RAILROAD LLC <u>PURSUANT TO 49 C.F.R. § 1180.2(d)(2)</u>

Chicago Rock Island & Pacific Railroad LLC (the "Rock Island"), a rail carrier, files this notice of exemption under 49 C.F.R. § 1180.2(d)(2) to continue in control of the Oklahoma & Kansas Railroad, LLC ("OKRL") upon OKRL becoming a railroad common carrier. Rock Island seeks the authority in anticipation of the transaction encompassed by the concurrently-filed notice of exemption in *Oklahoma & Kansas Railroad, LLC – Change of Operator Exemption – Oklahoma Department of Transportation and Blackwell Industrial Authority*, FD 36811 ("*OKRL – Exemption*").

The line over which OKRL intends to commence common carrier operations does not connect with Rock Island's lines or any of the lines of the two rail carriers that Rock Island controls – the Gulf & Ship Island Railroad LLC ("G&SI") and Ottawa Northern Railroad LLC ("ONR") – and this control transaction is not part of a series of anticipated transactions that would result in such a connection among any of Rock Island, GS&I, ONR, and OKRL. The subject control transaction does not involve a Class I carrier. Accordingly, Rock Island's continued control of OKRL (once OKRL becomes a carrier) satisfies the Section 1180.2(d)(2) class exemption criteria. In accordance with the requirements of 49 C.F.R. § 1180.4(g), Rock Island submits the following information:

Description of Proposed Transaction: 49 C.F.R. § 1180.6(a)(1)(i)

Rock Island is a rail carrier and rail carrier holding company which currently controls two other Class III rail carriers, G&SI and ONR.¹

OKRL, a non-carrier established and controlled by Rock Island, will lease and

operate the railroad lines described in OKRL - Exemption (the "Lines"). None of Rock Island's

railroad lines, G&SI's lines, or ONR's lines will connect with OKRL's Lines, and this control

transaction is not part of a series of anticipated transactions that would result in such inter-

connection. Rock Island seeks to continue in control of OKRL, G&SI, and ONR once OKRL

commences common carrier operations over the Line that is the subject of the transaction

encompassed by the OKRL – Exemption proceeding.

Proposed Schedule for Consummation: 49 C.F.R. § 1180.6(a)(1)(ii)

Rock Island intends to consummate the proposed control transaction upon the effectiveness of this exemption notice and the change of operator notice of exemption that is the subject of the *OKRL –Exemption*, in keeping with 49 C.F.R. § 1180.4(g)(1).

Purpose Sought to Be Accomplished: 49 C.F.R. § 1180.6(a)(1)(iii)

The subject exemption will allow Rock Island to continue to exercise common control of its existing rail carrier subsidiaries and OKRL. In turn, the control exemption will allow OKRL to proceed with its plans to commence common carrier operations over the Line pursuant to *OKRL – Exemption*.

States in Which Property of Applicants is Located: 49 C.F.R. § 1180.6(a)(5)

Mississippi – Rock Island and G&SI Kansas – ONR Oklahoma and Kansas – OKRL

Maps - Exhibits A and B: 49 C.F.R. § 1180.6(a)(6)

Attached as Exhibit A is map of the rail line OKRL will operate. Maps showing the location of Rock Island, G&SI, and ONR are attached as Exhibit B.

Agreement: 49 C.F.R. § 1180.6(a)(7)(ii)

Rock Island already controls OKRL as a non-carrier. No agreement is

contemplated or necessary for Rock Island to continue in control of OKRL once OKRL becomes a common carrier railroad.

Labor Protective Conditions: 49 C.F.R. § 1180.4(g)(1)(i)

Labor protective conditions are not available in transactions such as this one that involves only Class III carriers. 49 U.S.C. § 11326(c). Rock Island, G&SI, and ONR are Class III carriers, and OKLR will become a Class III carrier upon its commencement of common carrier operations pursuant to *OKRL – Exemption*.

Environmental and Historic Preservation Matters: 49 C.F.R. § 1180.4(g)(3)

Under 49 C.F.R. § 1105.6(c)(2)(i) and (ii), the proposed control transaction is exempt from environmental reporting requirements. Rock Island's continued control of OKRL will not result in changes that exceed the 49 C.F.R. § 1105.7(e)(4) or (5) thresholds.

Under 49 C.F.R. § 1105.8(b)(3), continued control also is exempt from historic preservation reporting requirements. The control transaction will not substantially change the level of maintenance of any railroad property.

Interchange Commitments: 49 C.F.R. § 1180.4(g)(4)

Continued control does not involve the acquisition or operation of a rail line, and thus the provisions of 49 C.F.R. § 1180.4(g)(4) are not applicable. In any event, the *OKRL* – *Exemption* transaction related to the present control exemption does not include a provision restricting OKRL's interchange of traffic with a third-party connecting carrier.



MAP OF OKLAHOMA & KANSAS RAILROAD, LLC




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
